

## Tetsuo Satoh, Ph.D. International Resource Consultant

Dr. Satoh's is an independent international resource consultant, with more than 40 years of experience, working with Spherix to provide strategic, scientific and regulatory guidance for clients. His primary research interest is the molecular mechanisms of metabolic activation of pharmacologically active chemicals.

Dr. Satoh completed his Ph.D. in 1966 and his M.S. in 1963, both in Pharmacology and Toxicology, Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Hokkaido. He received his B.A. in Pharmacology in 1955 from Toyama Medical and Pharmaceutical University.

In addition to his consulting work, Dr. Satoh currently serves as Professor Emeritus at Chiba University, and is currently working for the Director of NPO-HAB Research Institute. He held prior positions at Showa University, University of Mississippi Medical Center, Chulalongkorn University, Chiba University, University of Pharmacy and Life Sciences, and University of Chicago. Dr. Satoh has written more than 270 peer reviewed scientific articles.

Dr. Satoh served as Vice President of the International Union of Toxicology (IUTOX) from 1995-2001, and as Acting Vice President from 2002-2004. He was the Founding Secretary-General of the Asian Society of Toxicology from 1994-1995, and served as its Chair of the Scientific Program Committee from 1995-1997, as Councilor from 1994-2001, and as Advisor from 2001 to the present. Throughout the past 40 years, Dr. Satoh has served as a member of many pharmaceutical and toxicology societies.

Dr. Satoh has served on the Editorial Board of Human & Experimental Toxicology from 2000 to the present. He was Associate Editor of Toxicological Sciences from 2001-2004; Associate Editor of Regulatory Toxicology and Pharmacology from 1993 to the present; Founding Editor-in-Chief of Biological and Pharmaceutical Bulletin from 1992-1996, and Associate Editor of J. Toxicol. Sci. from 1987-2000. Dr. Satoh served on the Editorial Boards of Res. Commun. Mol. Pathol. Pharmacol. from 1986-2000, and Reviews in Environmental Toxicology from 1984-1989.
